## What are the problems caused by war

## **ECONOMICS**

- Decreased living standards, especially among socially unprotected groups
- Traditional approaches of doing business /economy have stopped working, innovation is needed, changes are required - training programs
- Outflow of employable population outside of Ukraine
- A significant gap in the educational level, abilities, skills of future graduates
- · Loss of work places
- Necessity to import goods that cannot be currently produced in Ukraine

## **INFRASTRUCTURE**

- Destroyed housing
- If there is work in hot spots, the inability to leave or take children away to continue normal studies
- Loss of great part of logistic infrastructures (ports, some railways, etc.);
- Loss and destruction of mills and production facilities
- Loss and destruction of educational institutions

## **HEALTH**

- Physical injuries leading to psychological ones require a longterm comprehensive recovery
- Inability to find oneself in a peaceful life, having lost home, job, health
- Social isolation of children, the destruction of their usual circle of communication, reduced physical activity - lead to disruption of normal development, especially for younger children





## **Humanitarian Aid**

#### **Basic needs**

- Since March 2022, Saving Lives has been helping Ukrainians with food kits and basic needs: food kits, hygiene products, and baby food.
- Each package contains eight kilograms of food: flour, sugar, pasta, canned goods, sunflower oil.
- A package of baby food contains three boxes of the product


#### 2 category



## Medicines and medical equipment

- The purpose is to support medical institutions of Zaporizhzhia, Kryvyi Rih, Avdiivka and Kamianske, because these cities have become hubs for displaced people and affected people from regions where active fighting is ongoing.
- We work closely with the city's military-civilian administrations and know what is needed locally.
- Thousands of catheters, intravenous cannulas, syringes, blood transfusion systems and gloves were donated to the Zaporizhzhia military hospital and the Kamianske city emergency hospital.
- The delivery of medicines and consumables to Kryvyi Rih has been established
- The doctors of the Kamianske Emergency Hospital received two modern surgical tables with the necessary accessories



• An expert-class anesthesia breathing system was delivered to Kryvyi Rih City Hospital. The anesthesia system is used in intensive care units and operating rooms to provide a patient with an anesthetic mixture, as well as artificial ventilation.





For the high-quality treatment of patients with shrapnel wounds and various types of injuries to the operating units of one of the hospitals in Kryvyi Rih, which functions as a hospital, the project transferred surgical sets of tools, including a device for treating wounds with negative pressure, a medical suction device, an electrosurgical device, a reusable video laryngoscope, an electrodermatome, operating table and lamp.

# Assistance to women and children in psychological and social rehabilitation

## **Unbreakable mom**

"Unbreakable Mom" is a project of the Masha Foundation, it was developed to stabilize the psycho-emotional state of participants, prevent the development of PTSD (post-traumatic stress disorder), form the ability for adaptation and self-realization, creation of new social ties.



As part of the program, women and children

- work with psychologists in groups and individually,
- undergo art therapy,
- Have excursions and walks along picturesque Carpathians,
- visit the hospital



Both for children and for adults, group classes are aimed at acquiring practical skills in the fight against stress. After the completion of the "Unbreakable Mom" program, all its participants will become real ambassadors of useful knowledge that will help maintain mental health during the war.

During the program, mothers were worked using the methods of EMDR, art therapy, mindfulness, psychodrama, body, narrative and cognitive behavioral therapy.

The children were engaged in neurogymnastics, play therapy, also practiced the "Serial Drawing" and "Safe Space" methods, developed stress resistance.

## Children's room

Almost 300 displaced persons from Mariupol, Avdiivka and other cities that came under shelling were welcomed in one of the shelters near Kamianske. 65 children found shelter here. To make their leisure time more informative and full of bright events, on the eve of the New Year, a large play room was installed in the shelter.

The room is full of various games for children of different ages and is divided into three sectors:

- A "soft" area has been created for children up to six years old, with bright hammocks, slides, a dry pool and interactive games.
- For children from six years old a variety of entertaining and educational table games.
- A cyber zone has been created for the oldest, where you can play game consoles with a set of the coolest games

## Prosthetics and rehabilitation of veterans and civilians



- - The program includes preparation for prosthetics, installation of prostheses and further observation in Ukrainian clinics, as well as physical and psychological rehabilitation.
  - Currently, 28 Ukrainians are being provided with assistance. In total, applications from more than half a hundred people are being processed.
  - The initiative covers Metinvest employees and their family members, military personnel and civilians in the company's regions.

- Another area in prosthetics is the creation of a Ukrainian online educational platform for specialists in limb prosthetics and related rehabilitation. Currently, the project team is preparing educational video lectures, and the platform itself is planned to be launched in February 2023.
- The goal of creating an educational platform is a broader and more systematic understanding of the needs of a person who has lost a limb; better provision of limb prosthetics and related rehabilitation services; understanding the route of a patient with a limb amputation from the moment of injury to returning home with a prosthesis.
